Instructional Paraprofessionals Needing to Meet No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Title I Requirements-

I. All Paraprofessionals providing Instruction in Title I Schoolwide Schools:

- Special Education Paraprofessionals
- Title I Paraprofessionals
- Cultural Liaisons (special education)
- Federal/State Indian Education Tutor
- Desegregation Tutor
- Bilingual Paraprofessionals
- English Language Learner Paraprofessionals
- Career Technical Education: Job Coach and Paraprofessionals

II. Paraprofessionals Needing to Meet NCLB Requirements in Targeted Assistance / Non-Schoolwide Title I Schools:

- Title I Paraprofessionals performing instructional duties (Excludes translators and parent liaisons)
- Career and Technical Education: Job Coach and Paraprofessionals (program approval)
